

A checklist for choosing a quality child care program.



Research is now available that can help parents make a better child care choice for their children. When you visit a child care program, find out the answers to the questions below.

Use this checklist as a guide in comparing programs. If you can answer **yes** to most or all of these questions, then your child will have a greater chance of having a successful child care experience.

Family Child Care Home Checklist

- yes* *no* Does the family child care home meet higher than minimal standards by having a 3 to 5-star rated license or a national accreditation through the National Association of Family Child Care?
- yes* *no* Is the family child care provider sensitive and responsive to the needs of each child enrolled?
- yes* *no* Does the family child care provider regularly participate in training opportunities, CPR and First Aid?
- yes* *no* Does the family child care provider see himself/herself as a child care professional?
- yes* *no* Does the family child care provider have planned activities for the children?
- yes* *no* Does the family child care provider have written policies and procedures for parents?
- yes* *no* Does the family child care provider have a credential or degree in early childhood education, child development, or a related field?
- yes* *no* Are parents always welcome in the home?
- yes* *no* Does the family child care provider participate in a family child care association or other professional association?
- yes* *no* Are there lots of materials and activities, such as blocks, puzzles and art supplies available for the children to explore all day long?
- yes* *no* Does the family child care provider have lots of experience and references from families who have used his/her service?
