The program also awards incentives for successful coursework or credential completion. TEACH scholarships may also be used along with other grants, such as Pell Grants.

TEACH Can Help Support Costs For:

- ✓ A few credits
- ✓ An early childhood certificate, diploma or associate degree
- ✓ An infant-toddler and preschool certificate
- ✓ A bachelor's degree
- ✓ A specialized graduate license
- ✓ A master's degree
- ✓ A CDA assessment or renewal credential

TEACH scholarships can be awarded retroactively to July 1, 2025, for the current academic year.
